Clothing

Tricky Words

On Thursday 28th September we will also begin sending home tricky words, in a plastic bag inside their reading record, these will be linked to the words we are learning in phonics lessons. Please practice recognising these and spelling them.

Reading Record and Book

Reading books and records will be handed out on Thursday 28th September. These books will be linked to the phonics we are teaching in class. This is an opportunity for them to get used to turning the pages, making a story up from the pictures, and recognising letters and words they have learnt during phonics. We are not expecting all children to be reading these independently straight away! Praise them for finding the letters they know or using the pictures to come up with a story plot of their own. Your feedback is essential and we really appreciate your written comments in the yellow reading record.

During this week we will be learning about changes and stages of growth. Could you please bring in a baby photo of your child, these will be photocopied and returned.

LITERACY

- I will be learning to recognise and write my name
- I will be learning different sounds that letters make (phonics sessions)
- I will be learning to write familiar words such as mum and dad
- I will be talking about my family
- I will be learning to write for a purpose e.g. making lists, labelling pictures
- I will take a reading book home to read

PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- I will be creating class rules with my friends
- I will be participating in turn taking games
- I will be learning routines of the school day
- I will be learning and talking about my family and other people who are important to me
- I will be learning about emotions

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

- I will be drawing pictures of myself using mirrors
- I will be drawing pictures of my family
- I will be thinking about colours and using them appropriately in my pictures
- I will be using a range of objects to print with e.g. sponges, hands
- I will be learning new songs to help me in my learning

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

- I will ask for things I need and ask for help when I need it
- I will be learning to talk about myself using describing words such as tall or short
- I will be imagining and recreating roles in real life family situations and fictional stories
- I will be asking questions to get to know my friends in my new class

MATHS

- I will be learning to recognise routines.
- I will be learning to talk about different times of the day.
- I will be exploring and using positional language.
- I will be learning number songs and rhymes.
- I will be learning how to use counting equipment.
- I will be learning to match objects.
- I will be learning to sort objects according to their properties.
- I will be learning to compare amounts.
- I will be learning to compare size, mass and capacity.
- I will be learning to make simple patterns.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- I will be playing games
- I will be negotiating space
- I will be using tools safely
- I will be learning about how to be healthy
- I will be using a range of small and large equipment
- I will be using a range of malleable materials
- I will be eating a range of healthy snacks
