Dear Parent/Carer,

Next term, the children in Year 1 will be learning about castles in History. To complement this, we would like to take all the children to Legoland, where they will be taking part in a castle building workshop and have a chance to explore other attractions in the park.

The trip will take place on Tuesday 4th June. All the children will travel by coach from Knowle Green base, leaving at 9.15am and we will return to school at approximately 3pm, depending upon traffic. Children will need to bring a packed lunch and water bottle, in a named rucksack. Please remember no glass bottles, cans of drink or nuts of any kind. Children should wear their Riverbridge jumpers with their yellow top and jogging bottoms from their PE kit together with trainers. They should also bring a named waterproof coat and if there is sunshine, please send a named sun hat and apply sun cream in the morning.

We may require some parent helpers to accompany us on the visits. If you are able to help please can you email office.riverbridge@lumenlearningtrust.co.uk We will then contact you once we have confirmed the number of adult helpers required.

The cost of the trip will be £23.50 and is based on all children in Year 1 taking part; we are happy for you to make payment in instalments over the next couple of months with final payments made by 4th June. Unfortunately, if your child has a Legoland pass this will not be valid for school/group visits. As always, if the cost is a concern, please speak to the school office in confidence.

An online consent is available for this trip and must be ticked as soon as possible via www.scopay.com/riverbridge-pri this consent box must be ticked to give permission for your child to take part in the activities. We are unable to allow the children to take part unless this has been ticked. The contribution is voluntary, however if there is insufficient support, the trip may be cancelled. As a school we cannot fund this type of enrichment visit without voluntary contributions.
