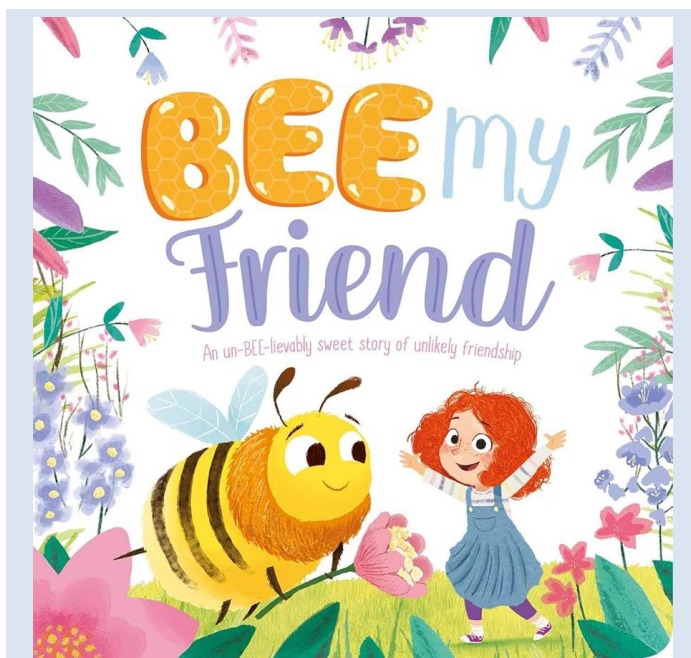
This week's 'Riverbridge Reading Recommendation' comes from Harper in 1R
