Please ensure that your child arrives in the school hall at PAB by 8.30am on Tuesday 19th November; we will be registering the children at 8.40am, so please say your goodbyes and well-wishes then. We are due to depart school at 9.30am.

Final reminders:

- Full suggested 'kit list' is on the reverse of this letter - please pack for all weathers.
- All bedding is provided but children must bring a towel
- Up to £10.00 pocket money in a labelled purse/wallet (nothing too large)
- Disposable packed lunch for the journey down to Bristol - Please do not bring a lunch box or bag
- **NO** electronics, including smart watches (e.g. Apple Watch)
- A refillable water bottle
- Black bag for dirty clothes
- Please ensure **ALL** medication is handed to the medical desk in the hall on the morning of departure, with a blue form, which **must** be completed if you wish for staff to administer medication. This includes travel sickness tablets.

Finally, if any contact details have changed since you submitted your forms, please ensure that you make a member of staff aware.

Please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher if you have any further questions. **We are due back by approximately 4pm on Friday 22nd November, but we will update parents via text messages on route to confirm timings.**

What to bring:

Walking to the locations will continue whatever the weather. So please be prepared.

- Refillable water bottle
- Small rucksack for the day
- Three sets of warm clothing, including:
 - T-shirts
 - socks
 - fleeces/sweatshirts
 - long trousers – tracksuit bottoms or loose-fitting trousers are better than jeans.
- Underwear for four days
- Nightclothes
- Waterproof jacket e.g. cagoule or anorak
- Warm coat, hat, scarf and gloves for cold weather
- Two pairs of comfortable walking shoes e.g. boots or trainers (this means if one set is wet your child will still have something dry to wear on their feet)
- A wash bag including:
 - hairbrush
 - shampoo
 - shower gel/soap
 - toothbrush & toothpaste
 - deodorant – (**not** aerosols)
- Towel
- Bin bag (labelled) – for dirty clothes
- A small board game or deck of cards to play in free time
- £10 (coins and note mix) maximum in a re-sealable purse/wallet envelope or sandwich bag with your child's name on it. This must be handed in at the money desk on the Tuesday morning. (We will be visiting many places with gift shops, which sells small souvenirs). We will give each child time to spend this throughout the week.

**ALL items must be named to help with the children's personal organisation
and they are less likely to get lost**

What not to bring:

- Electrical devices (including smart watches)
- Mobile phones
- Jewellery
- Precious or expensive items
- Food or sweets
- Extra money

Any of these items that are brought will be confiscated and kept by a teacher until our return to school.
