Writing:

- Write for different purposes

Reading:

- Be introduced to non-fiction books that are structured in different ways
- Use non-fiction texts to ask and answer questions

MATHS

Addition and Subtraction

- Add and subtract 2 two-digit numbers using regrouping and a place value grid.
- Add 3 1-digit numbers together.
- Solve addition and subtraction problems.

Shape

- Identify and name 2D and 3D shapes
- Describe the properties of 2D & 3D shapes (2D: sides and corners, 3D: the number of edges, vertices and faces)
- Identify one vertical line of symmetry on a 2D shape

SCIENCE

Materials:

- Distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made
- Identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock
- Describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials
- Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties

HISTORY

The Great Fire of London:

- Learn about events beyond living memory that are significant nationally or globally
- Use sources to investigate the past
- Identify the causes of the Great Fire of London
- Sequence the events of the Great Fire of London
