Dear Parent/Carer,

In the Summer term, the children will be studying Animals, including Humans. As part of this topic, the children will be visiting Legoland to take part in a workshop where they will learn about the characteristics of animals, their habitats, and the importance of adaptation for their survival. The children The visit will provide a valuable opportunity to enrich their understanding through real-life experiences.

The trip will take place on Tuesday 2nd June. All the children will travel by coach from Knowle Green base, returning to school at approximately 3pm, depending upon traffic. Children will need to bring a packed lunch and water bottle, in a named rucksack. Please remember no fizzy drinks, glass bottles, cans of drink or nuts of any kind. Children should wear their Riverbridge jumpers with their yellow top and jogging bottoms from their PE kit together with trainers. They should also bring a named waterproof coat and if there is sunshine, please send a named sun hat and apply sun cream in the morning.

We may require some parent helpers to accompany us on the visits. If you are able to help please can you email office.riverbridge@lumenlearningtrust.co.uk We will then contact you once we have confirmed the number of adult helpers required.

The cost of the trip will be £27.10 and is based on all children in Year 1 taking part; we are happy for you to make payment in instalments as follows:- £7.10 by 31st March, £10 by 30th April & £10 by 29th May making a total of £27.10. If your child has a valid Legoland / Merlin pass the cost of the trip will be £13.60 please complete the form included on the email sent with this letter. If the cost is a concern, please speak to the school office in confidence.

An online consent is available for this trip and must be ticked as soon as possible via www.scopay.com/riverbridge-pri this consent box must be ticked to give permission for your child to take part in the activities. The contribution is voluntary, however if there is insufficient support, the trip may be cancelled. As a school we cannot fund this type of enrichment visit without voluntary contributions. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium and therefore free school meals we are able to provide a packed lunch for your child. Please let the school office know by 18th May if you require a packed lunch to be provided.
