Use of children's images

Whole School

In light of ongoing national conversations about children and social media, we have reviewed the use of children's images within our own social media accounts and across our online presence as a Trust. You may have noticed our accounts have not had faces on them for a little while and this is because we have chosen to adopt a 'face-free' policy for now. We will keep this decision under review and make you aware of any changes.

We have made all reasonable endeavours to remove historical images; if you come across an image from school with children clearly in it, please make the office staff aware and they will take appropriate action.

Free School Meal Eligibility

Reception – Year 6

We want to make sure that we are providing your child with the best education and support we can. Healthy school food can help pupils establish healthy habits for life and help to improve pupils' readiness to learn.

From September 2026 if you receive Universal Credit your child will be entitled to receive free school meals (FSM) You could also raise additional pupil premium funding for your child's school.

The information collected in the google form below will allow an assessment of your entitlement. You only need to complete this form once, subsequent rechecks of your eligibility will be carried out annually as a minimum to assess whether you continue to be eligible for free school meals.

The results will show if you are eligible for targeted (FSM & Pupil Premium) or expanded (FSM only). These results are subject to change, should your financial circumstances change. You should contact the school if you have a change in financial circumstances.

What to do

If you receive Universal Credit please fill in all sections of the form found on the link below, and submit to the school. If there is any information you cannot find, or you are having problems understanding, contact the school office for help.

Parent Governor Vacancy - Ballot to take place

We are so pleased with the response to our request for parent governor nominees and have received 2 nominations. This means a vote will take place to appoint 1 nominee.

Parent governors are welcomed as valued members of the governor team and play an important role; the governing body works together as a group, meeting once each term and undertaking visits to the school. Governors work alongside the school leaders on the strategic planning to strengthen provision.

Anyone with parental responsibility for a child at the school is entitled to a vote and we would encourage you all to use this vote. This can be done easily by completing the ballot form via this link <https://forms.gle/pqfEP7YegSDp2DZC6>.

When considering who to vote for please consider the following:

- The Local Governing Body (LGB) is a sub-committee of the Board of Directors and has an advisory role. Directors value the input from local governors who provide an insight into the lived experience at the school.
- A parent governor is a representative parent on the LGB and their role is strategic and not about the day to day operation of the school. Any issues that may arise for parents that relate to their child or operation of the school need to be raised with the appropriate member of staff and not through the parent governor.

We are incredibly lucky to have parents who wish to put themselves forward for the role and I would like to wish everyone the best in the ballot.

We need to hold a ballot for the vacancy of parent governor at our school. Anyone with parental responsibility for a pupil is entitled to a vote. This can be done easily via this link <https://forms.gle/pqfEP7YegSDp2DZC6> Voting closes on 10 July at 3pm.

Trischa Zorn-Hudson Swimmer

This week we learned about Trischa Zorn-Hudson, an extraordinary Paralympic swimmer.

Trischa Zorn-Hudson was born with a visual impairment and is legally blind. From a young age, she discovered a love for swimming and worked incredibly hard to develop her skills. Through dedication and perseverance, she became one of the most successful Paralympic athletes in history, winning many medals and breaking world records.

We talked about her achievements and the commitment needed to become a top athlete. We also discussed how sport can help build confidence, teamwork, and resilience.

Through studying Trischa's story, pupils explored important values such as:

- Never giving up
- Working hard towards goals
- Supporting and encouraging others
- Celebrating everyone's abilities and achievements

Hopefully learning about Trischa Zorn-Hudson, may have inspired the children to believe in themselves, try new challenges, and recognise that determination and positivity can help them achieve remarkable things.
