We will find out about their life, how they overcame obstacles and how they demonstrated determination to succeed.

Henri Matisse Artist



On Monday, we found out about the famous artist Henri Matisse and explored how colour, shape, and creativity can be used to express ideas and emotions.

Henri Matisse was a French artist who became well known for his bright colours, bold patterns, and imaginative artwork. He believed that art should bring joy and used colour in exciting and unusual ways to make people feel happy and inspired.

We also found out about Matisse's "cut-out" artworks. Later in his life, when he became unwell and found painting difficult, he began creating pictures by cutting shapes from coloured paper and arranging them into beautiful designs. He called this "painting with scissors."

Being inspired by Matisse has been well timed as this week has been Art Week. There have been lots of different activities for children to explore including:

- Experimenting with colour and pattern
- Exploring shape and composition
- Learning how art can express feelings and imagination

Children have discovered, like Matisse, that there is no single “right way” to make art.

“Creativity takes courage.”
